Course Overview

The Enterprise Risk Monitoring, Reporting & Performance Management Training Course provides a practical and strategic framework for monitoring enterprise risk exposure, transforming risk information into meaningful management intelligence, and integrating risk performance into organizational decision-making. Participants will learn how to connect risk exposure with performance outcomes and identify situations where strong financial or operational results may conceal increasing levels of underlying risk.

Through practical exercises, dashboard development, indicator design, risk reporting simulations, trend analysis, performance assessments, and executive reporting workshops, participants will develop the capabilities required to establish an effective enterprise risk monitoring and reporting environment.

Objectives

- Measure the effectiveness of risk mitigation and management actions.
- Assess the maturity and effectiveness of enterprise risk monitoring.
- Develop a continuous improvement roadmap for risk monitoring, reporting, and performance management.
