Course Overview

Tax Policy Development & Regulatory Impact Assessment is a practical training course focused on developing effective tax policies and assessing the regulatory, fiscal, economic, and administrative impact of proposed tax measures.

- Develop evidence-based recommendations for tax policy decisions.
- Evaluate risks associated with proposed tax reforms.
- Design practical monitoring and evaluation approaches for tax policies.
